

## How to Build a Simple Herb Planter Box from Scrap Wood

Turn leftover lumber into a beautiful, raised herb planter box. This beginner-friendly build is perfect for patios, porches, or backyard gardens.

### Materials:

- 2x4 or 1x6 scrap boards
- Wood screws or nails
- Drill or hammer
- Measuring tape
- Saw (hand saw or circular)
- Soil and herb plants

### Steps:

1. Cut your wood into four panels for the sides (about 18 to 24 inches long).
2. Screw or nail the panels together to form a box frame.
3. Add a bottom using slats or leave open for ground planting.
4. Drill small holes in the bottom for drainage if needed.
5. Sand rough edges and optionally paint or stain.
6. Fill with soil and add your favorite herbs!
